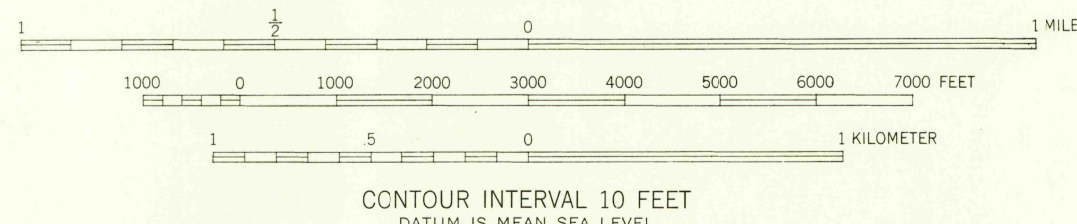

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown

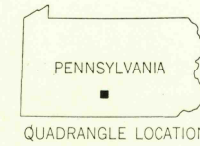
TRILE NORTH
