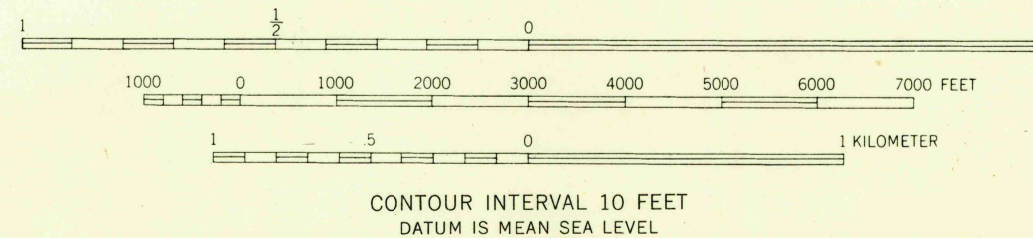

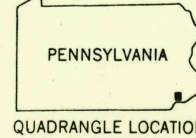
APPROXIMATE MEAN
