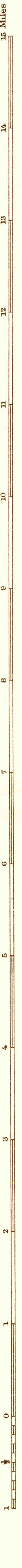
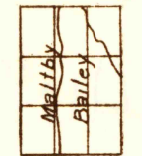


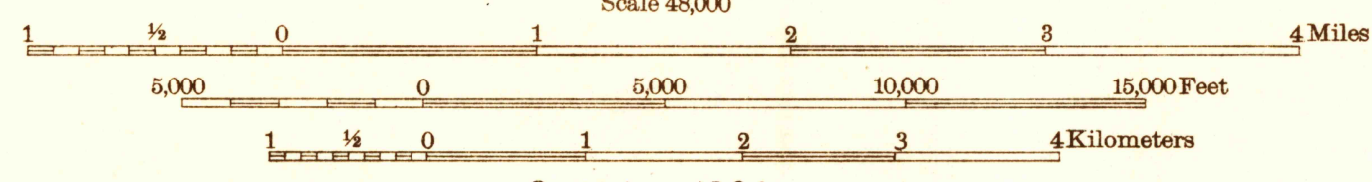
THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE MAP OF STARRUCA  
QUADRANGLE, SURVEYED IN 1924, SCALE 1:62,500



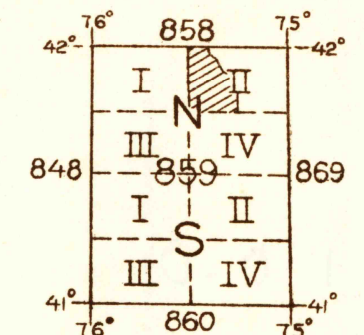
