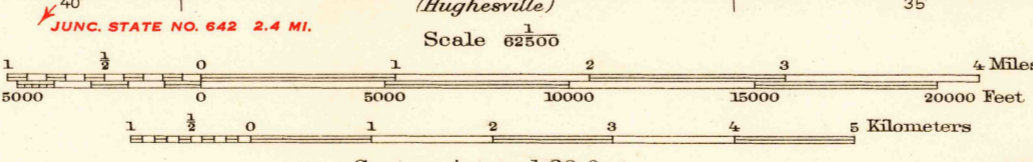
PENNSYLVANIA EAGLES MERE QUADRANGLE
