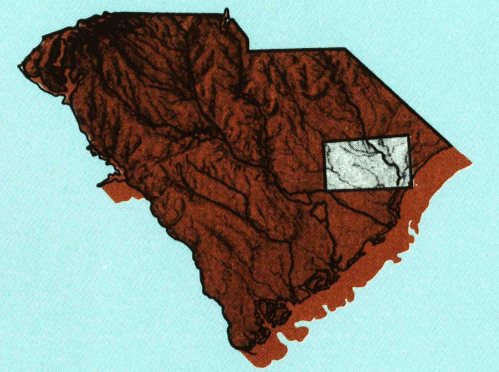


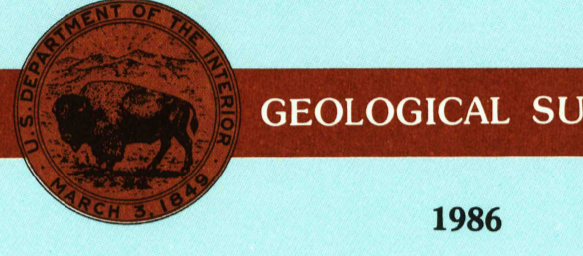
# Kingstree SOUTH CAROLINA

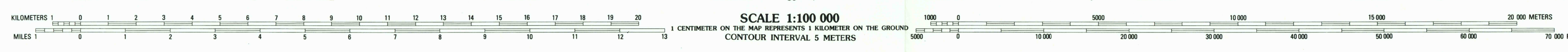
UTM grid convergence (RM and 100 magnetic declination (MM) at center of map
