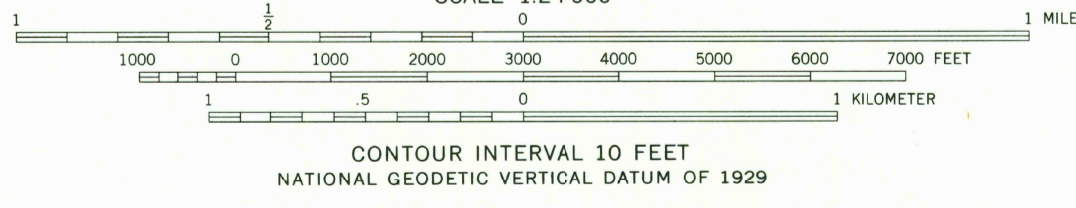
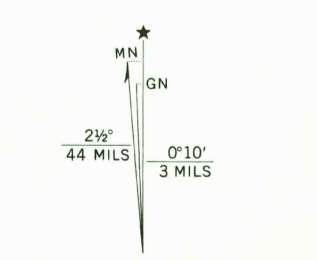

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 14 meters south and 16 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
Short dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines visible on aerial photographs
