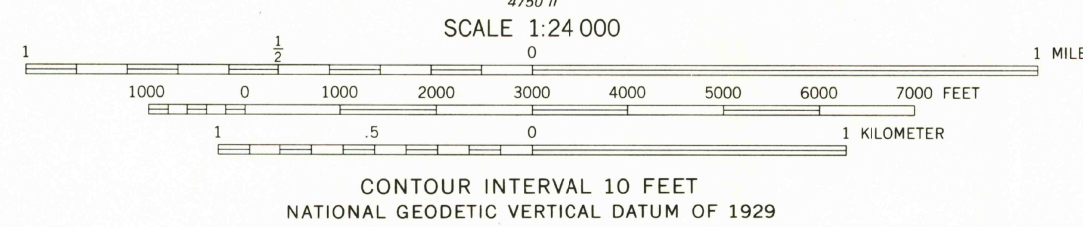
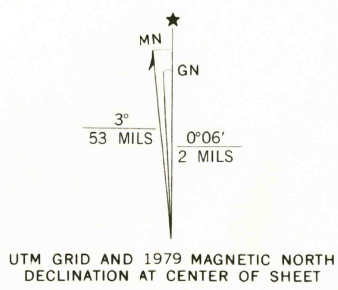

16 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where  
generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked  
Short dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines  
visible on aerial photographs  
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
