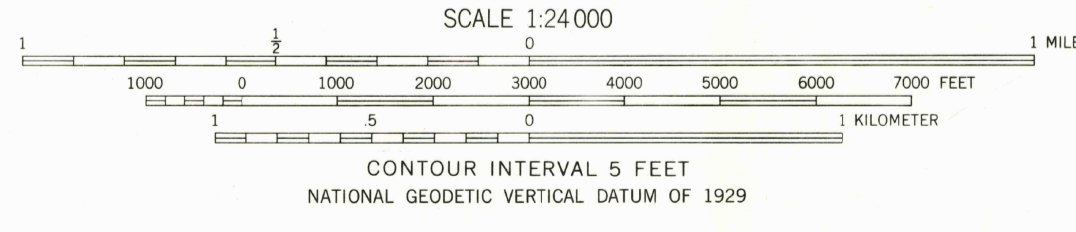
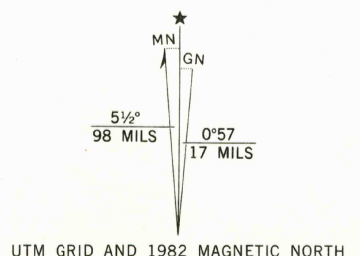

Short dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines visible
