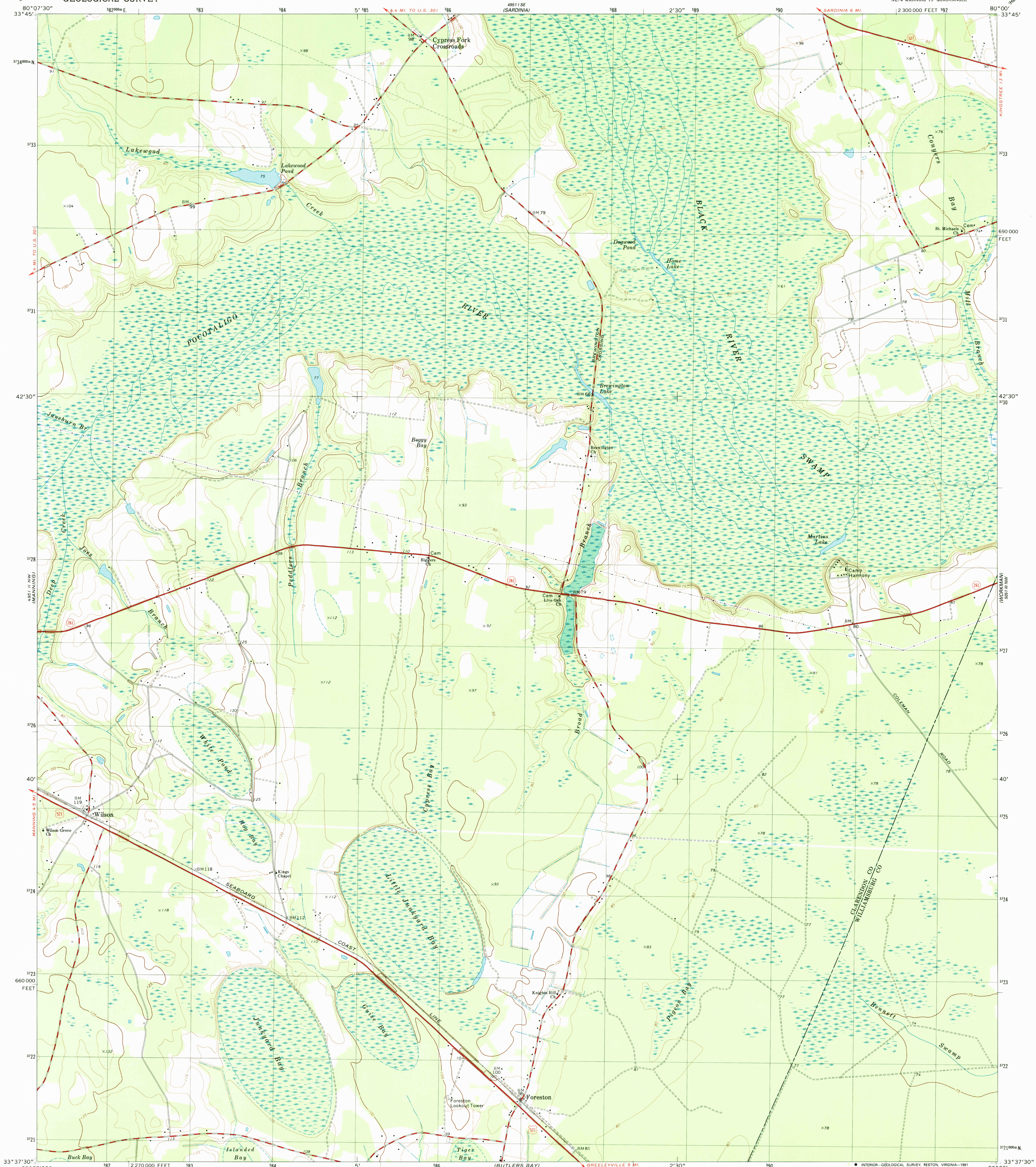

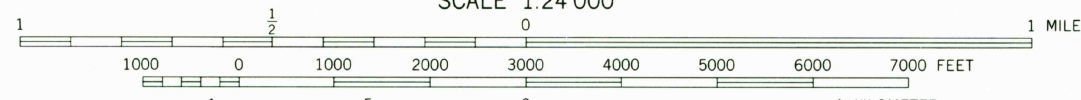
1927 North American Datum
