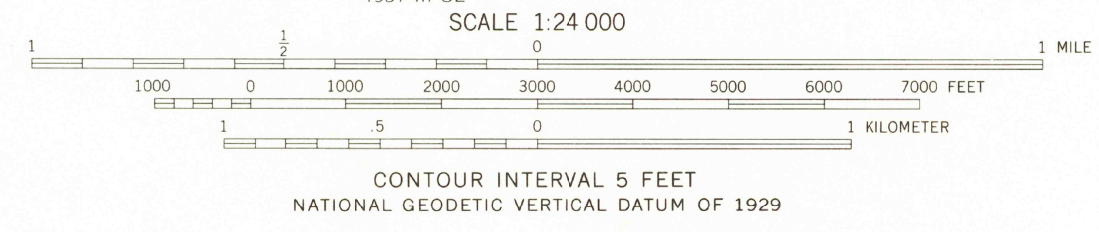
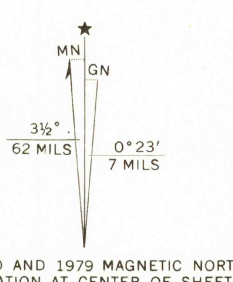

Short dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines visible on aerial photographs
