

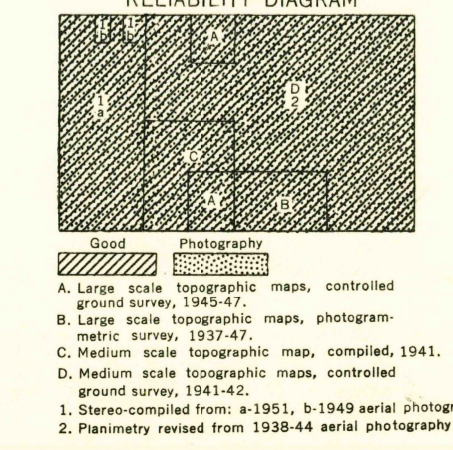

LEGEND ROAD DATA 1953. Includes symbols for populated places (Boston, Richmond, Evanson, Hialeah, Bar Harbor, Fishkill), roads (hard surface, light duty, dirt), railroads, boundaries, and landmarks.

Scale 1:250,000. Includes a scale bar in statute and nautical miles, contour interval information (100 feet with supplementary contours at 50 foot intervals), and projection details (Transverse Mercator Projection).
