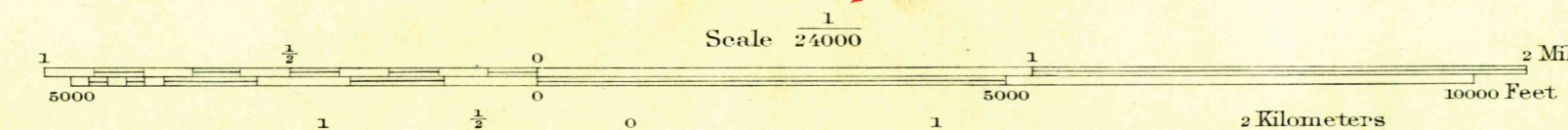
TENNESSEE-VIRGINIA PLUM GROVE QUADRANGLE
