Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1956 and by planetable methods 1950. Field checked 1968.

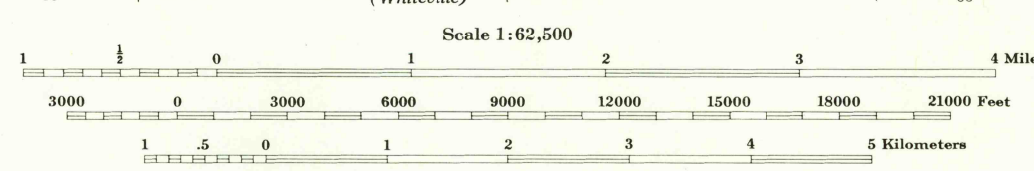

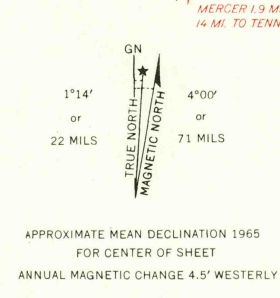


DATUM IS MEAN SEA LEVEL
