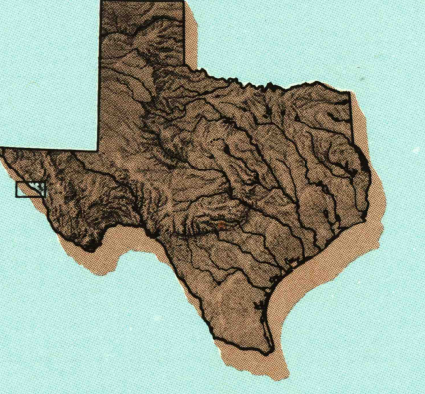


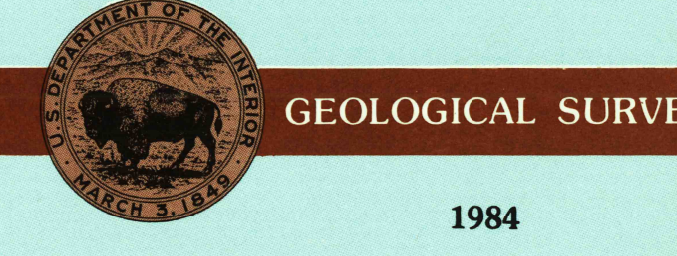
Indian Hot Spring TEXAS
