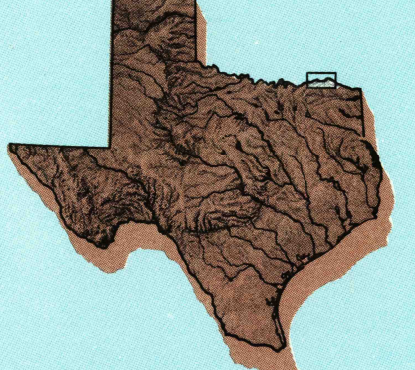


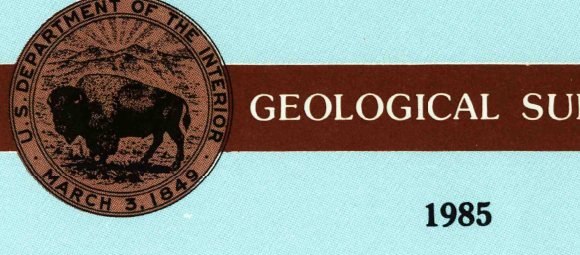
# Paris TEXAS-OKLAHOMA
