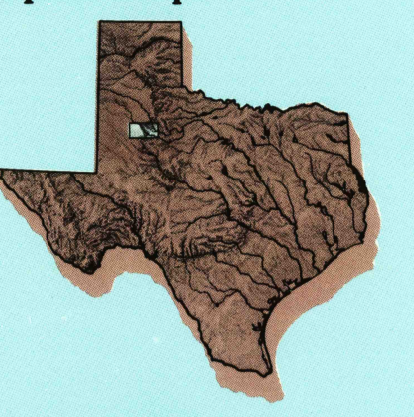


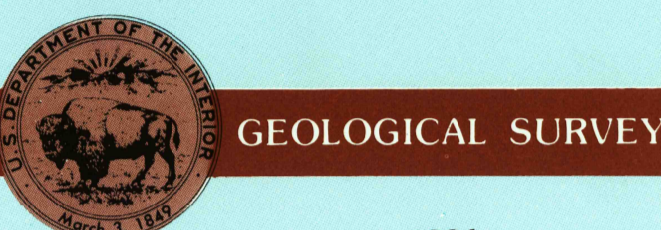
# Slaton TEXAS

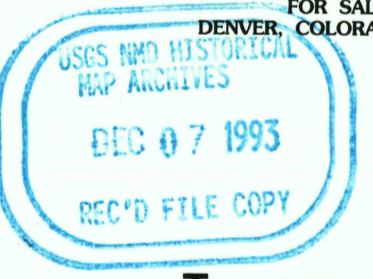
