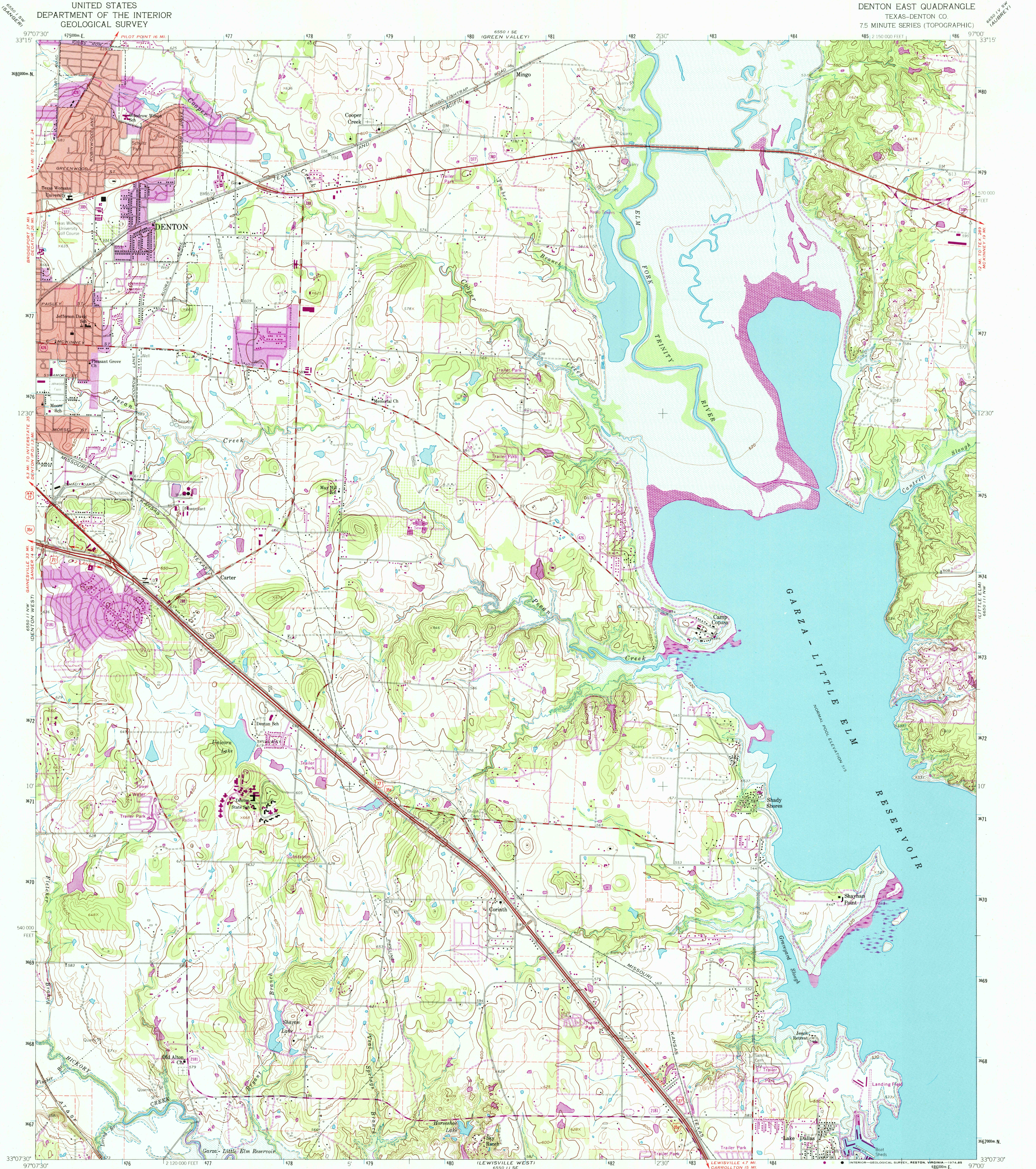


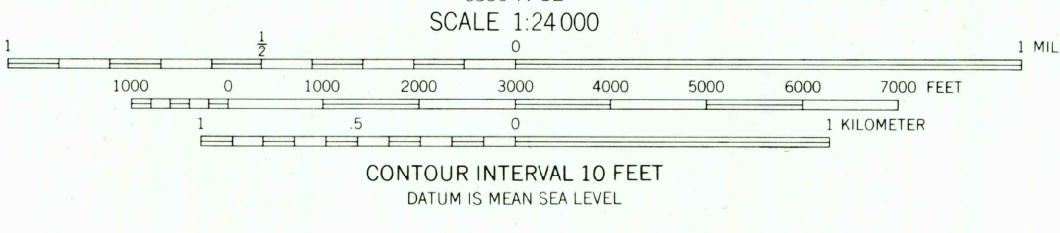

zone 14, shown in blue
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines
where generally visible on aerial photographs
This information is uncheckered
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject
to controlled inundation to 532 feet

Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs
taken 1968 and 1973. This information not field checked
Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas
