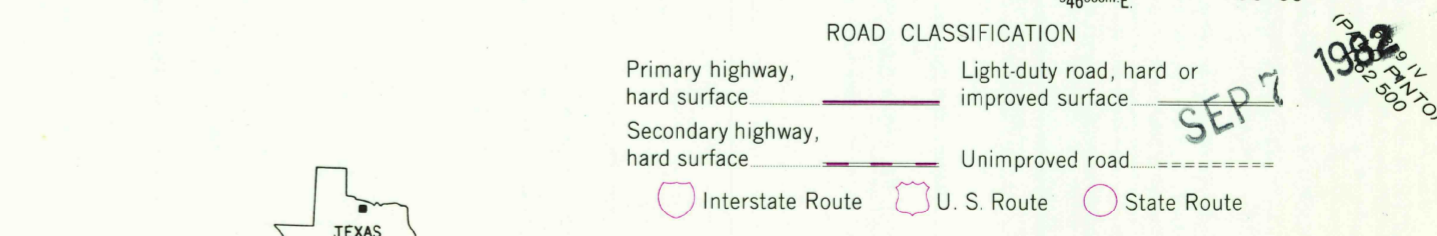
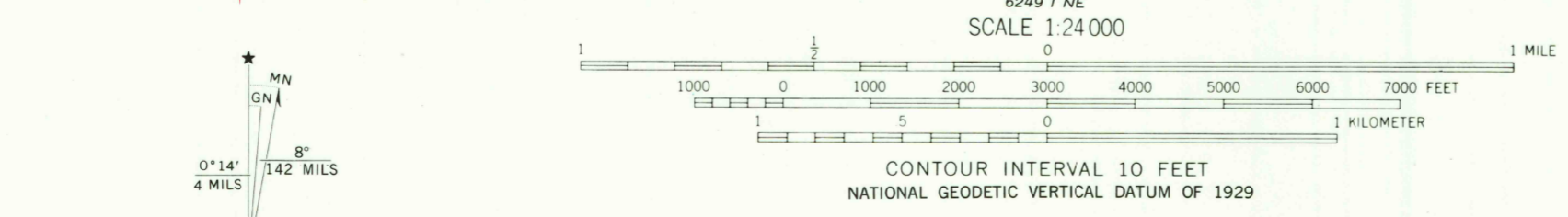

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters south and 32 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines  
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation
