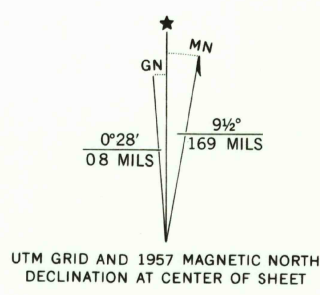

zone 14, shown in blue



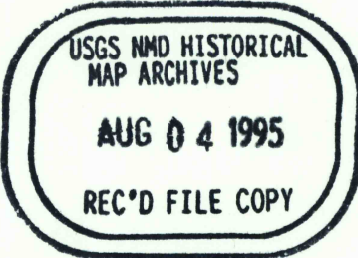
