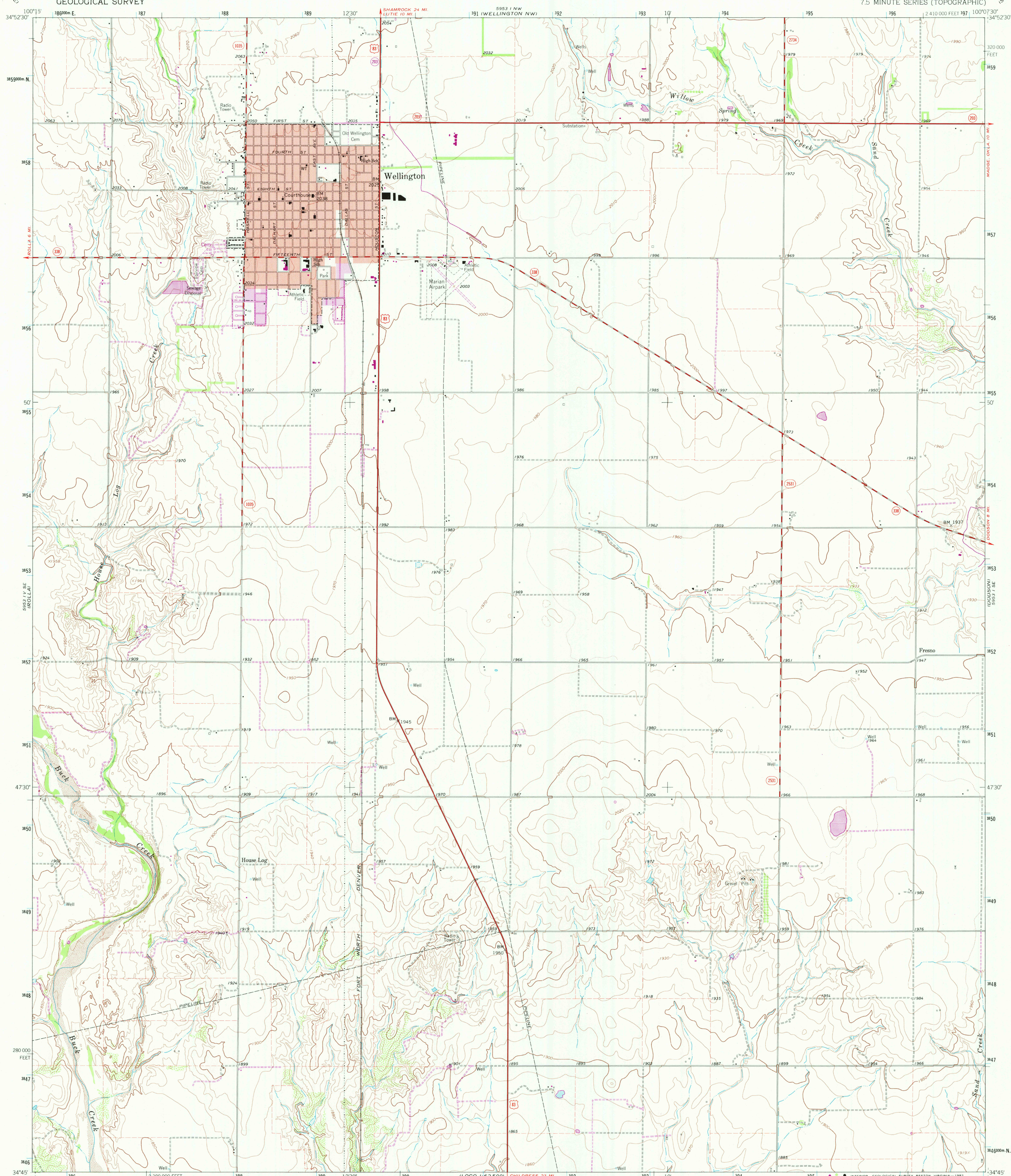
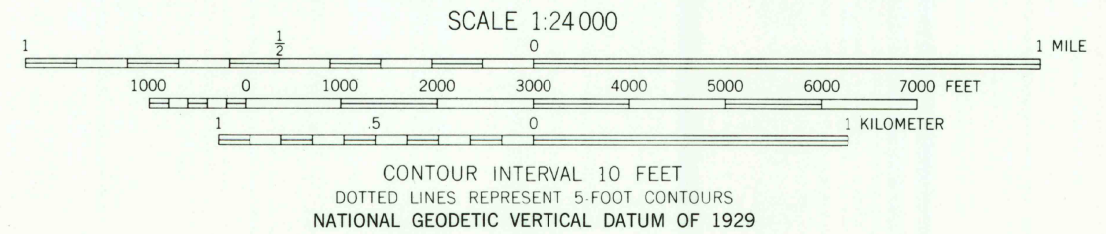
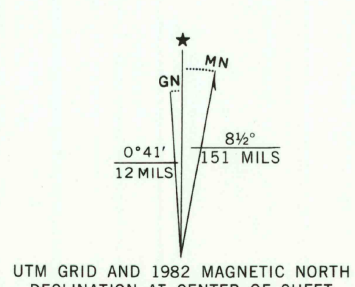

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Texas coordinate system, north zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 14, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 36 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines.
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.
Revisions shown in purple and woodland compiled from aerial photographs taken 1979 and other sources. This information not field checked. Map edited 1982.
Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas.
