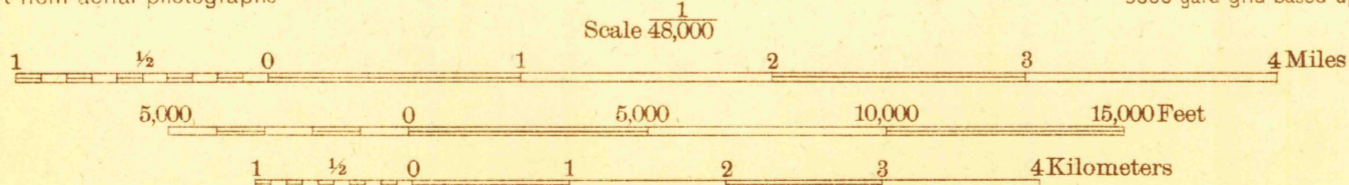

BURNET 3-b QUADRANGLE



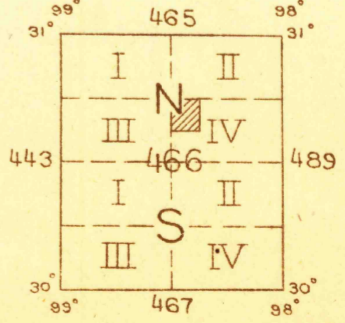
