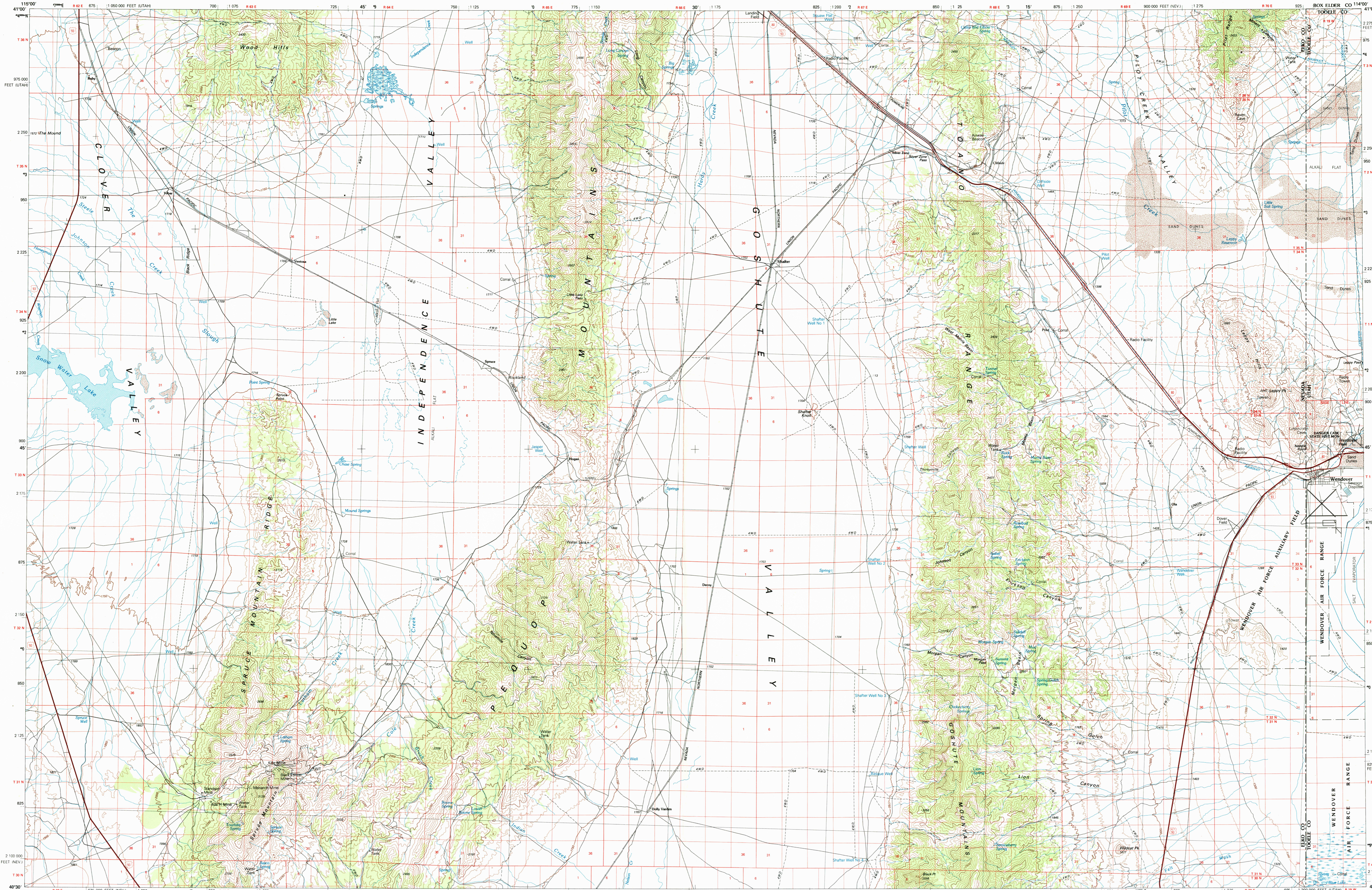

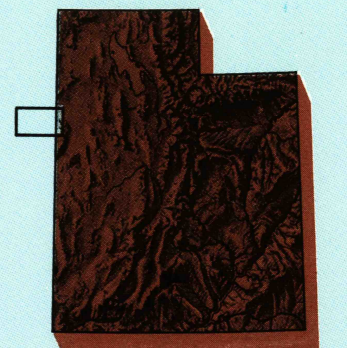

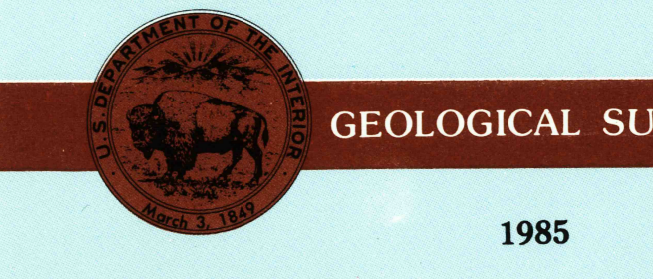

Projection and 10 000-meter grid, zone 11, Universal Transverse Mercator. 25 000-foot grid ticks based on Nevada coordinate system, east zone and Utah coordinate system, central zone, 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 11 meters north and 72 meters east. There may be private holdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
