Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

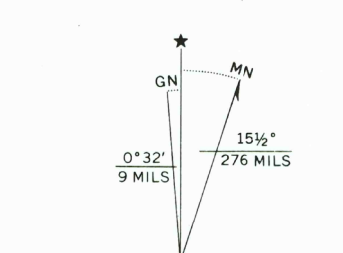
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

zone 12, shown in blue

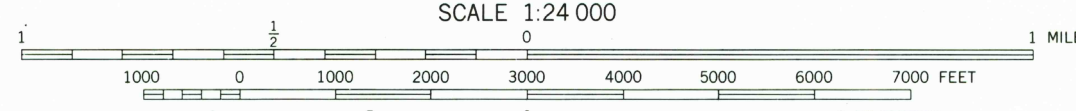
