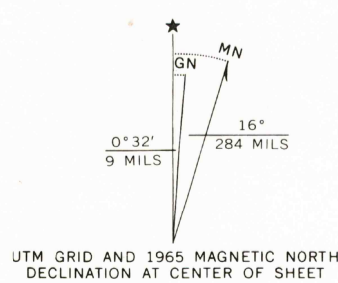
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum

10,000-foot grid based on Utah coordinate system, central and north zones

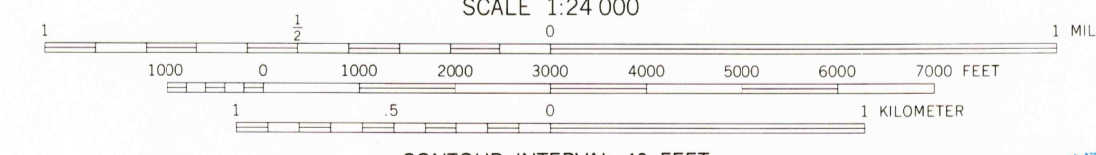
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue
