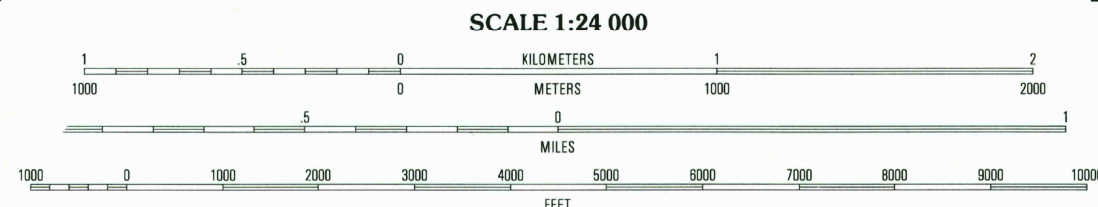
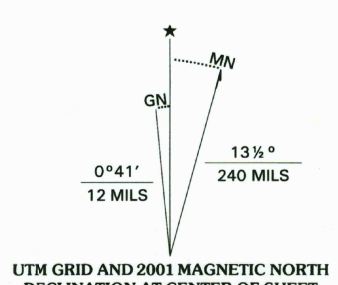

Projection and 1 000-meter grid: Universal Transverse Mercator, zone 12. 2 500-meter ticks: Utah Coordinate System of 1983 (central zone). North American Datum of 1927 (NAD 27) is shown by dashed corner ticks. The values of the shift between NAD 83 and NAD 27 for 7.5-minute intersections are obtainable from National Geodetic Survey NADCON software. Houses of worship, schools, and other labeled buildings verified 1989.
