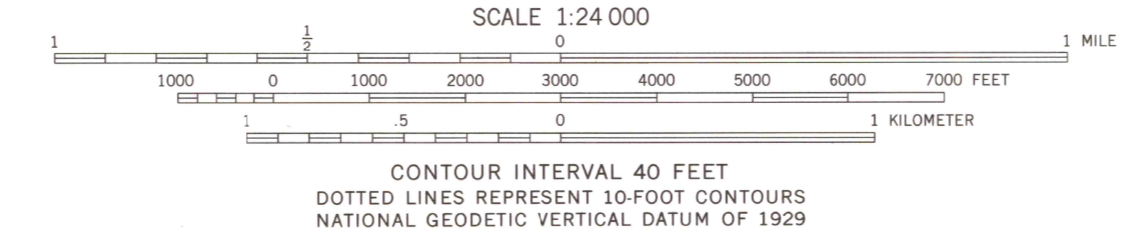

The difference between 1927 North American Datum and North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) for 7.5 minute intersections is given in USGS Bulletin 1875. The NAD 83 is shown by dashed corner ticks. Dashed land lines indicate approximate location. Unchecked elevations are shown in brown.
