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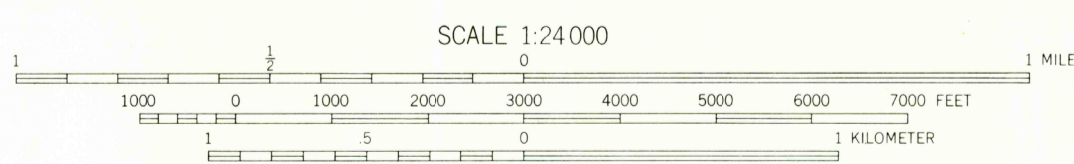
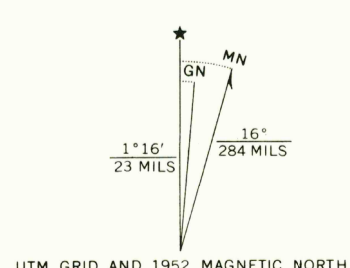

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum, 10,000-foot grids based on Utah coordinate system, north zone and Colorado coordinate system, north zone

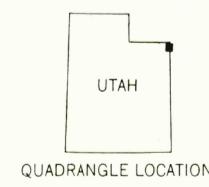
