

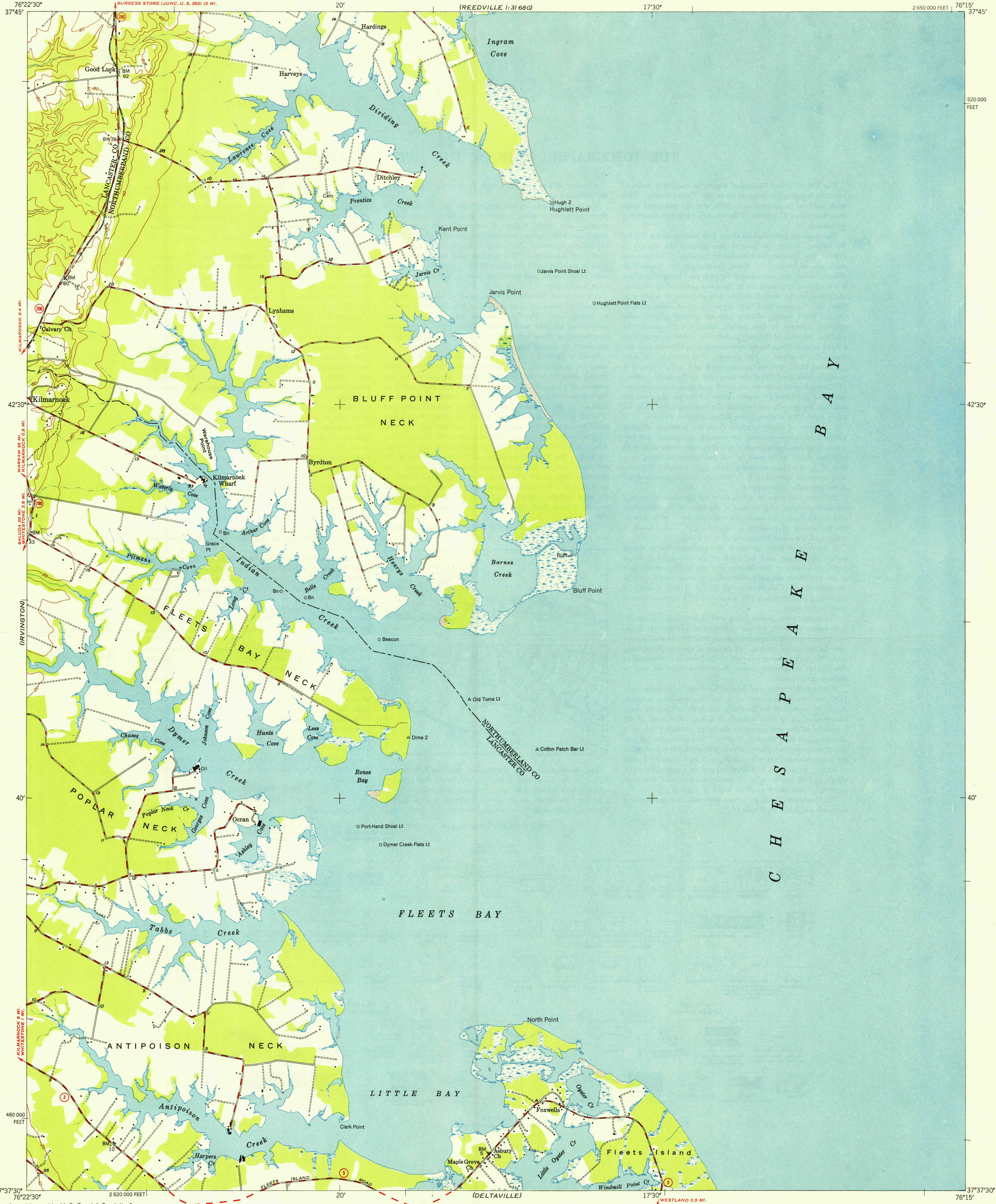

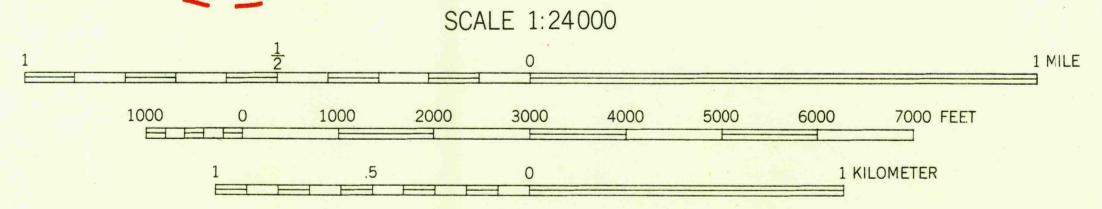
FLEETS BAY QUADRANGLE VIRGINIA 7.5 MINUTE SERIES (TOPOGRAPHIC)
