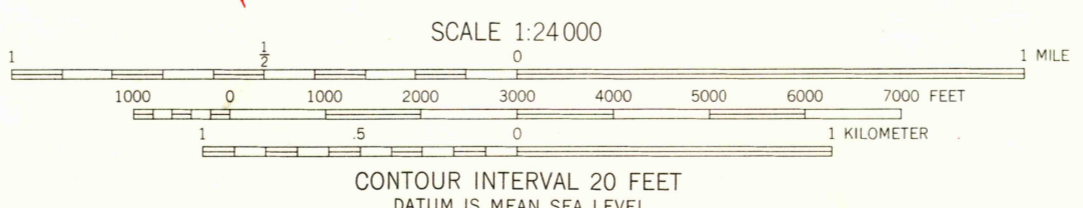

zone 18, shown in blue

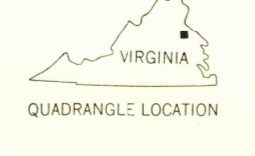
APPROXIMATE MEAN
