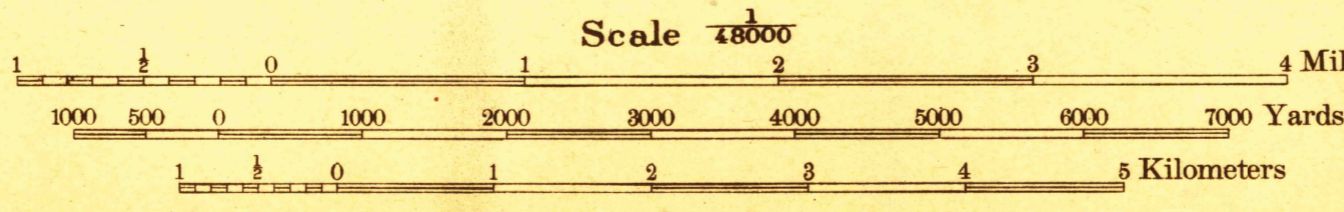

HOMEVILLE QUADRANGLE

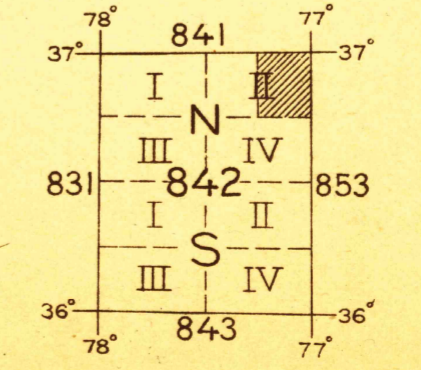
