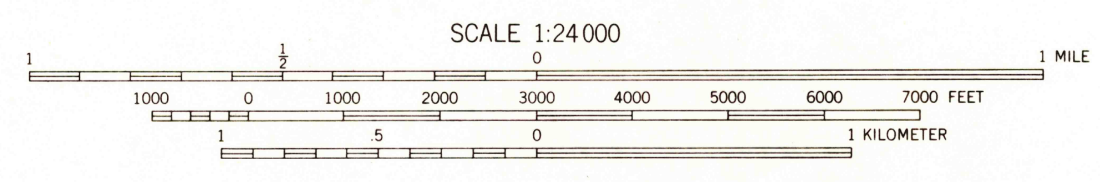
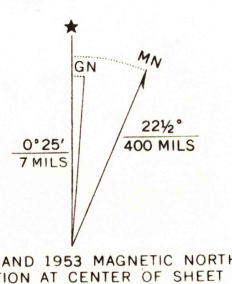

zone 10, shown in blue

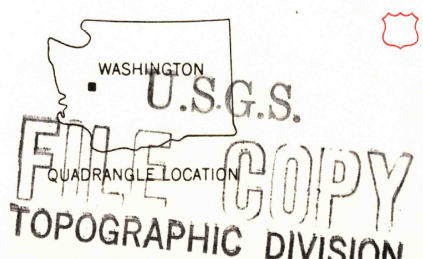


CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 FEET
