landmark buildings are shown

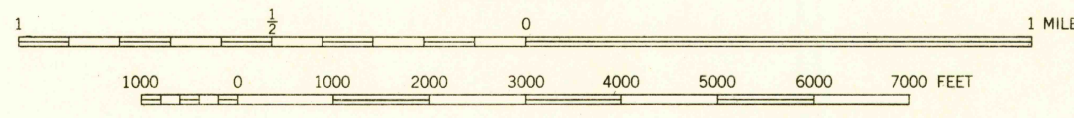
No distinction is made between dwellings, barns,

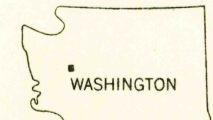
