

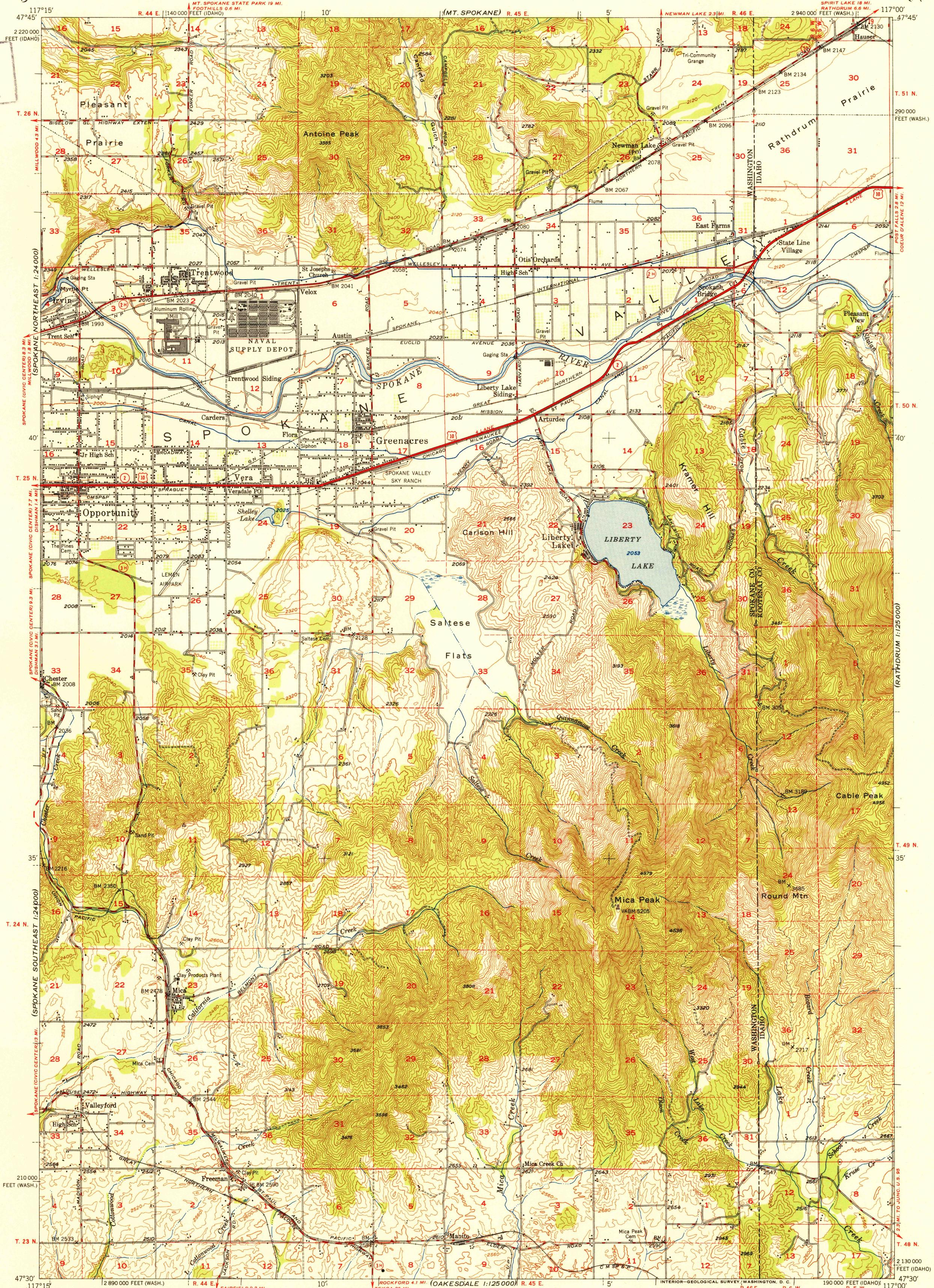

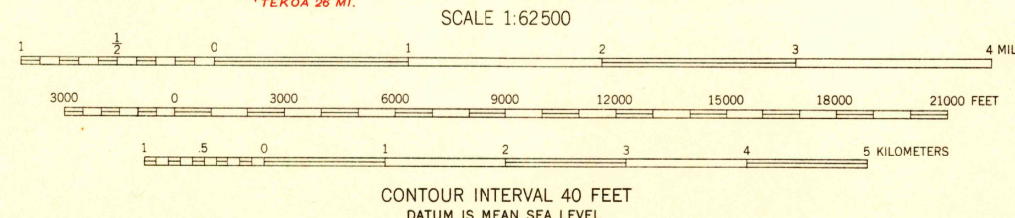
GREENACRES QUADRANGLE
