QUADRANGLE, SURVEYED IN 1935-1938, SCALE 1:125,000

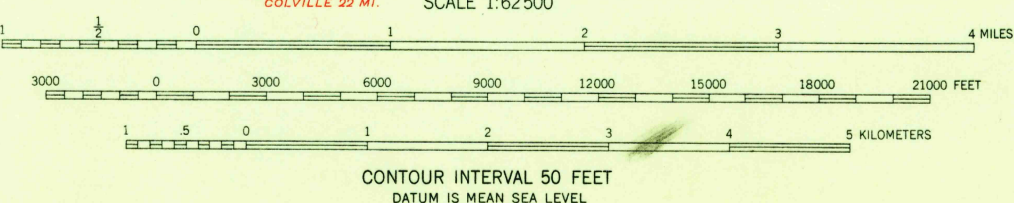
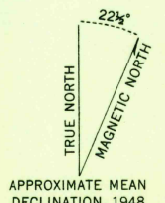
