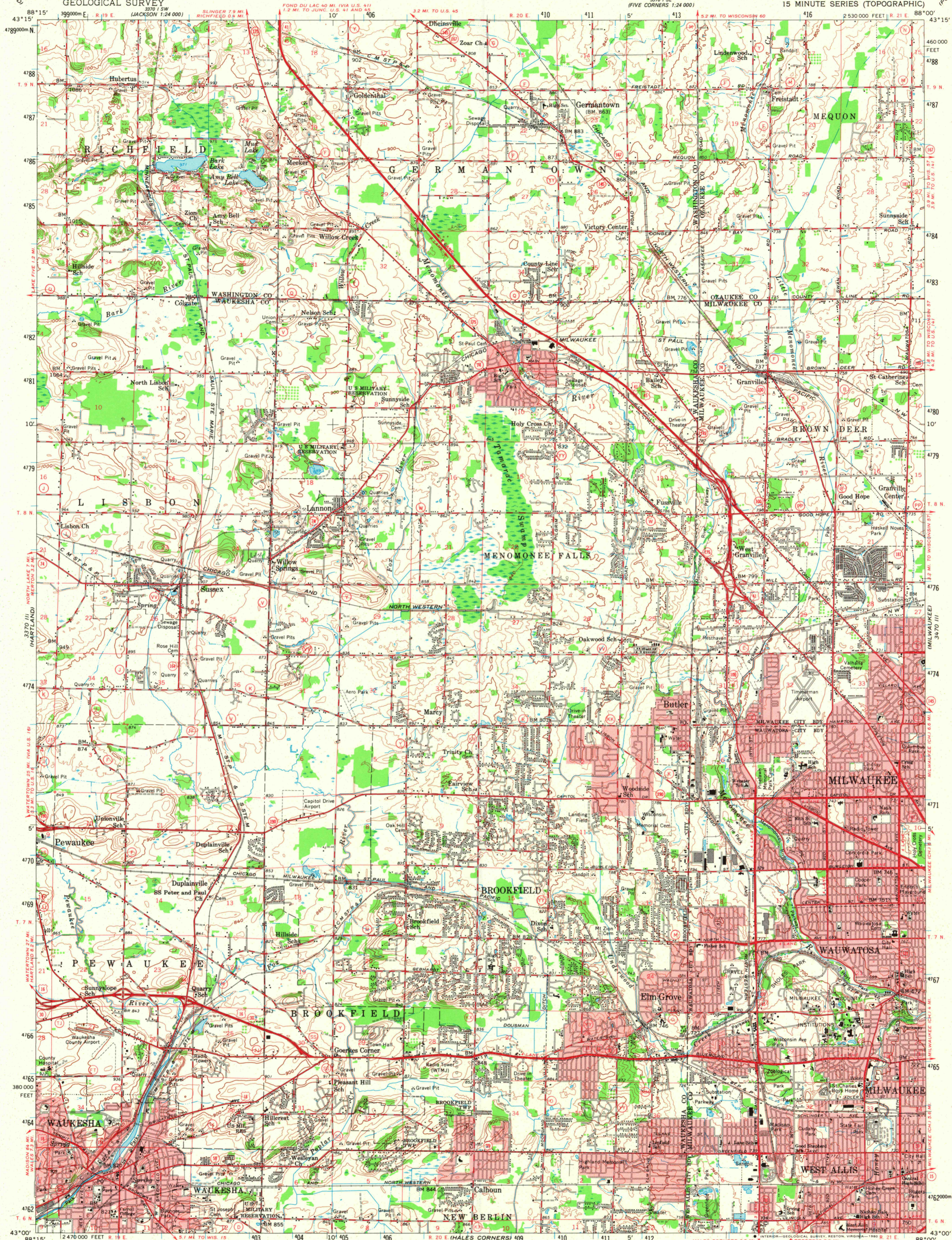
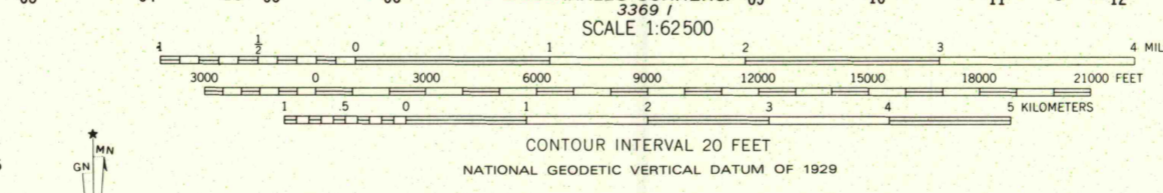

Topography from aerial photographs by photogrammetric methods and in part by the City of Brookfield. Aerial photographs taken 1954-1955
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum
10,000-foot grid based on Wisconsin coordinate system, south zone
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters north and 6 meters east
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
