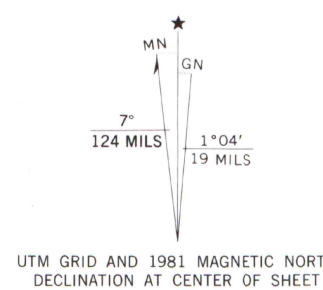

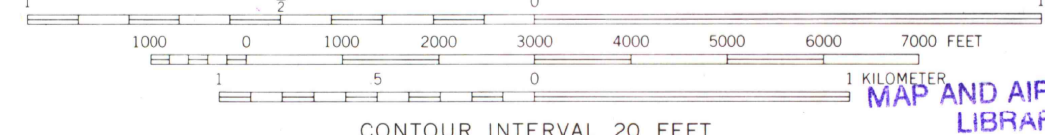
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters south and 21 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
