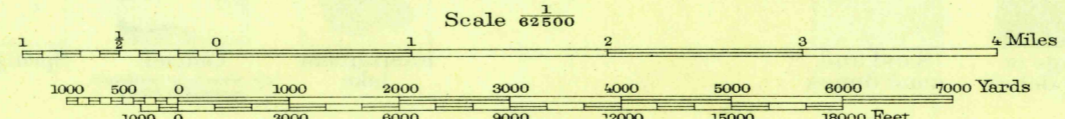
WEST VIRGINIA VADIS QUADRANGLE
