



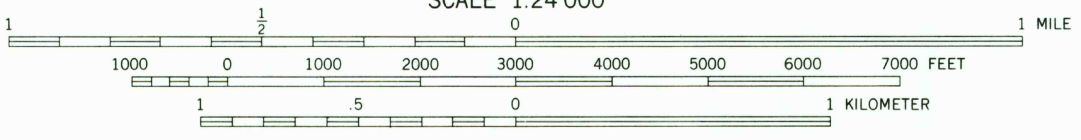
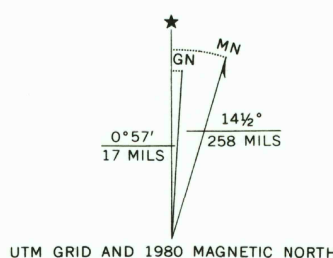

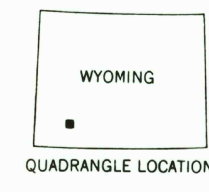
Fine red dashed line indicates selected fence line
