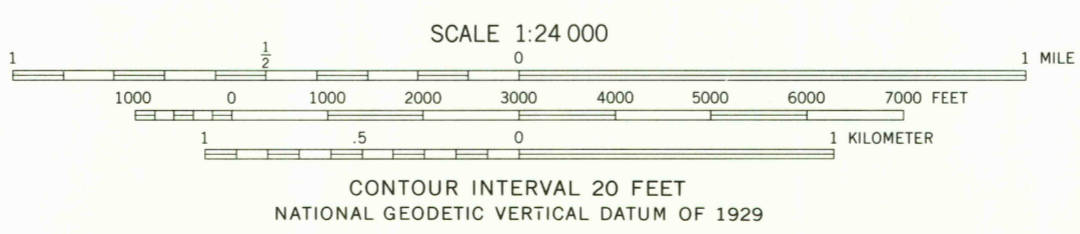
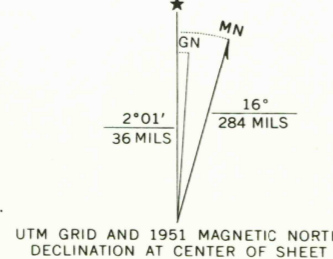

10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west central zone

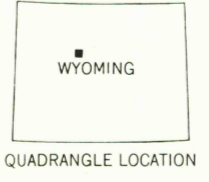
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
