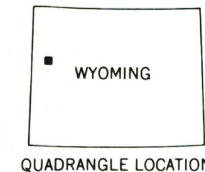
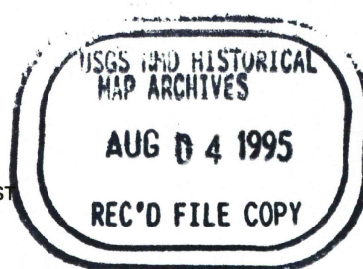
DARWIN PEAK QUADRANGLE
