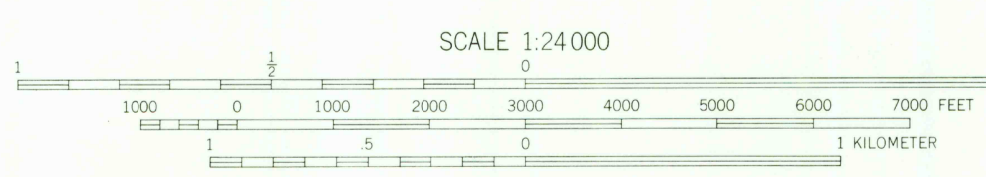
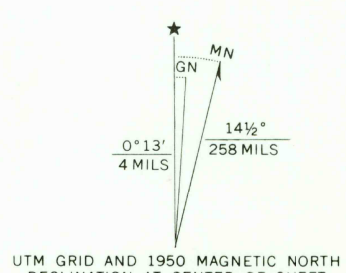
Topography from aerial photographs by multiple methods. Aerial photographs taken May-June 1947 and September 1948. Field Check 1950.

Dashed land lines indicate approximate location.

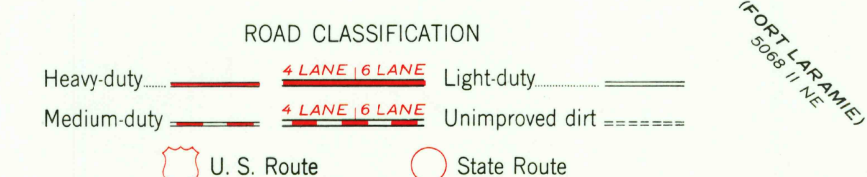
Unchecked elevations shown in brown.
