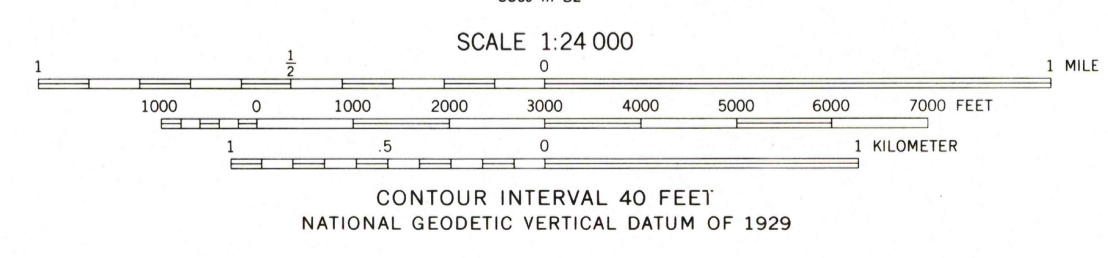
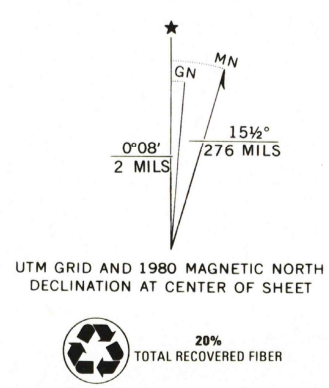

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Wyoming coordinate system, west zone (transverse Mercator) 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 12 1927 North American datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 11 meters north and 62 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. Land lines have not been established in this area. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
