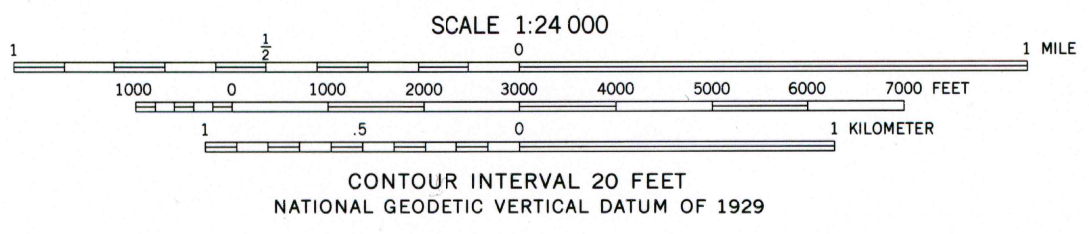
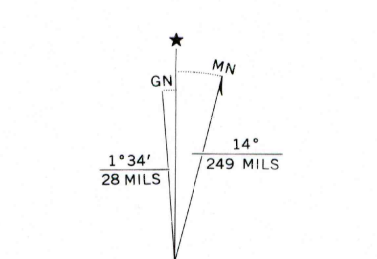

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters north and 51 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
