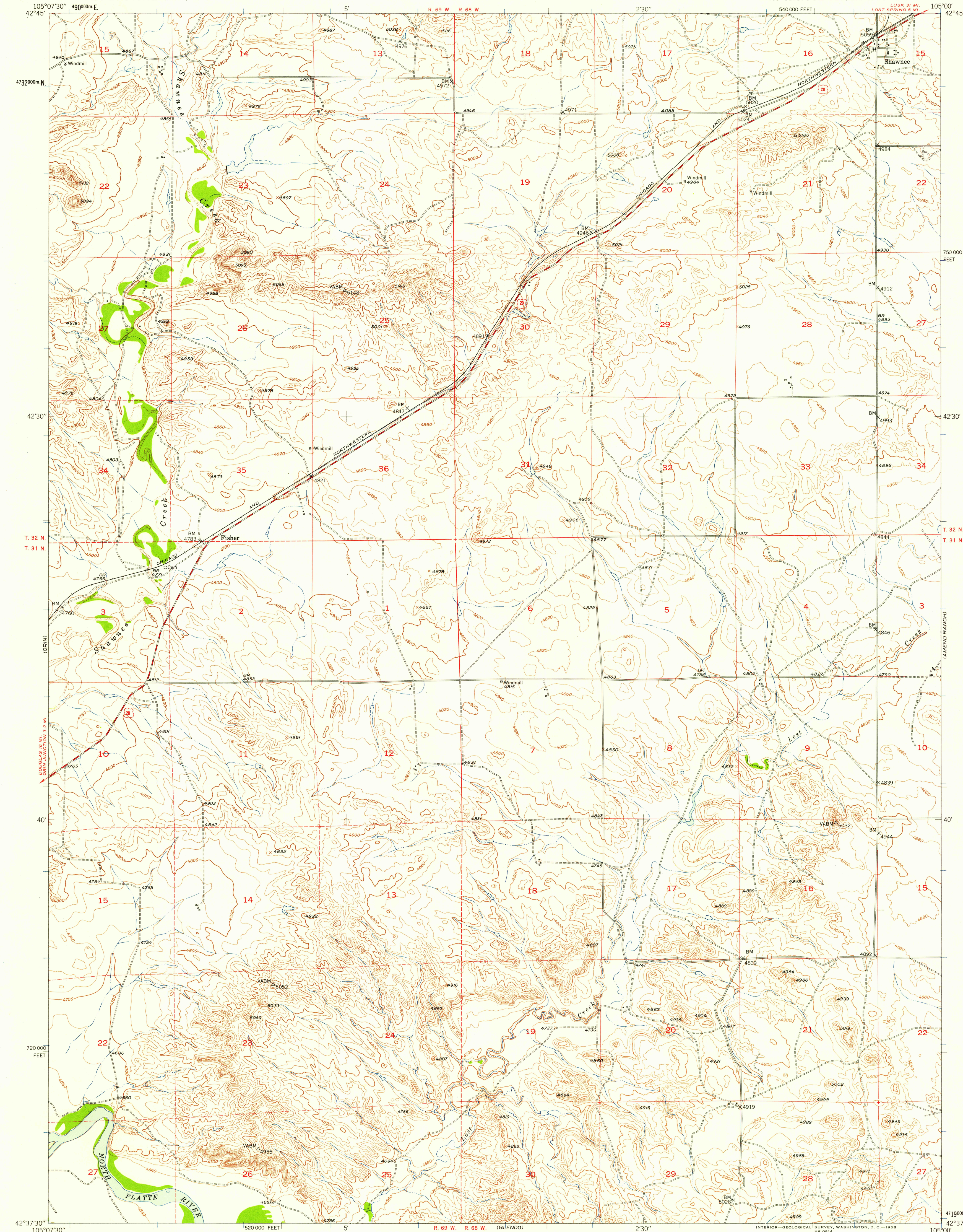

Aerial photographs taken June 1947. Field check 1949

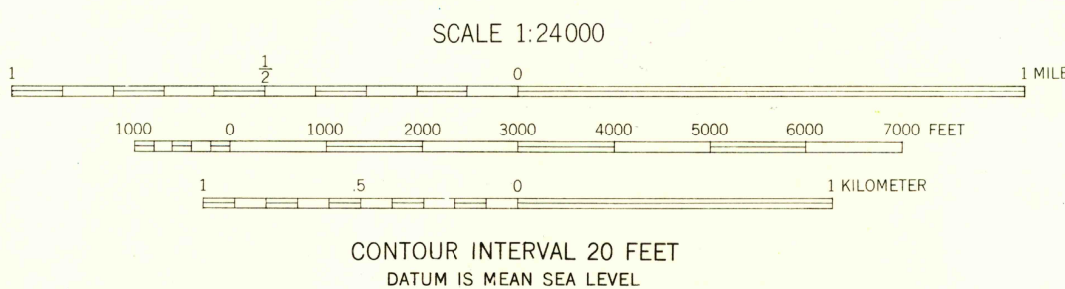
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum
