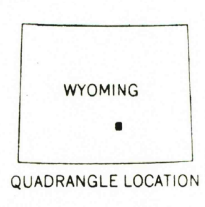
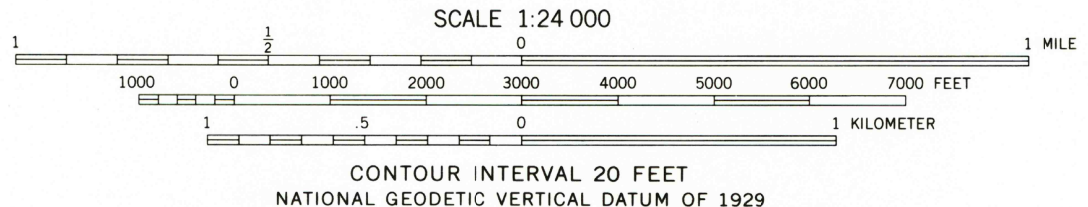
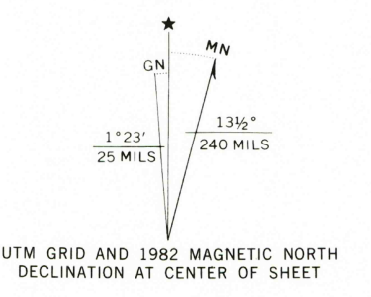

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters north and 51 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
