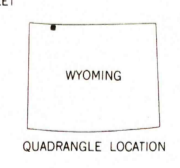
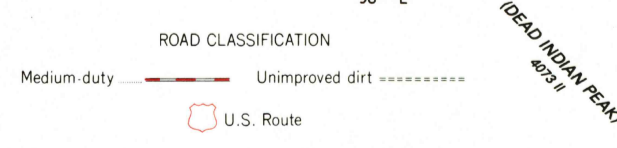
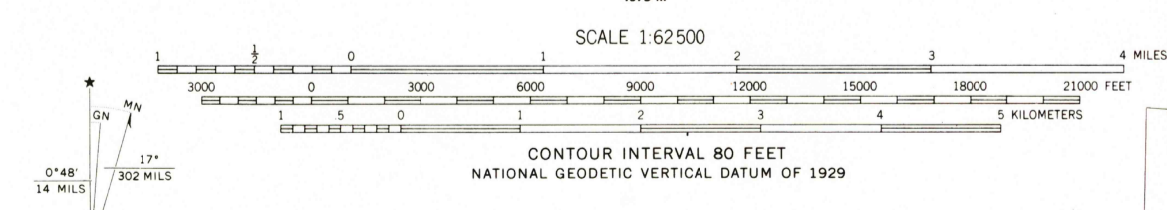

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 10 meters north and 45 meters east. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
