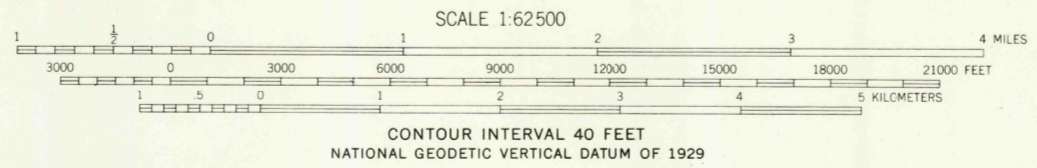
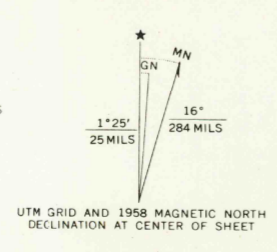

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west central zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue. Unchecked elevations are shown in brown. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters north and 56 meters east.
