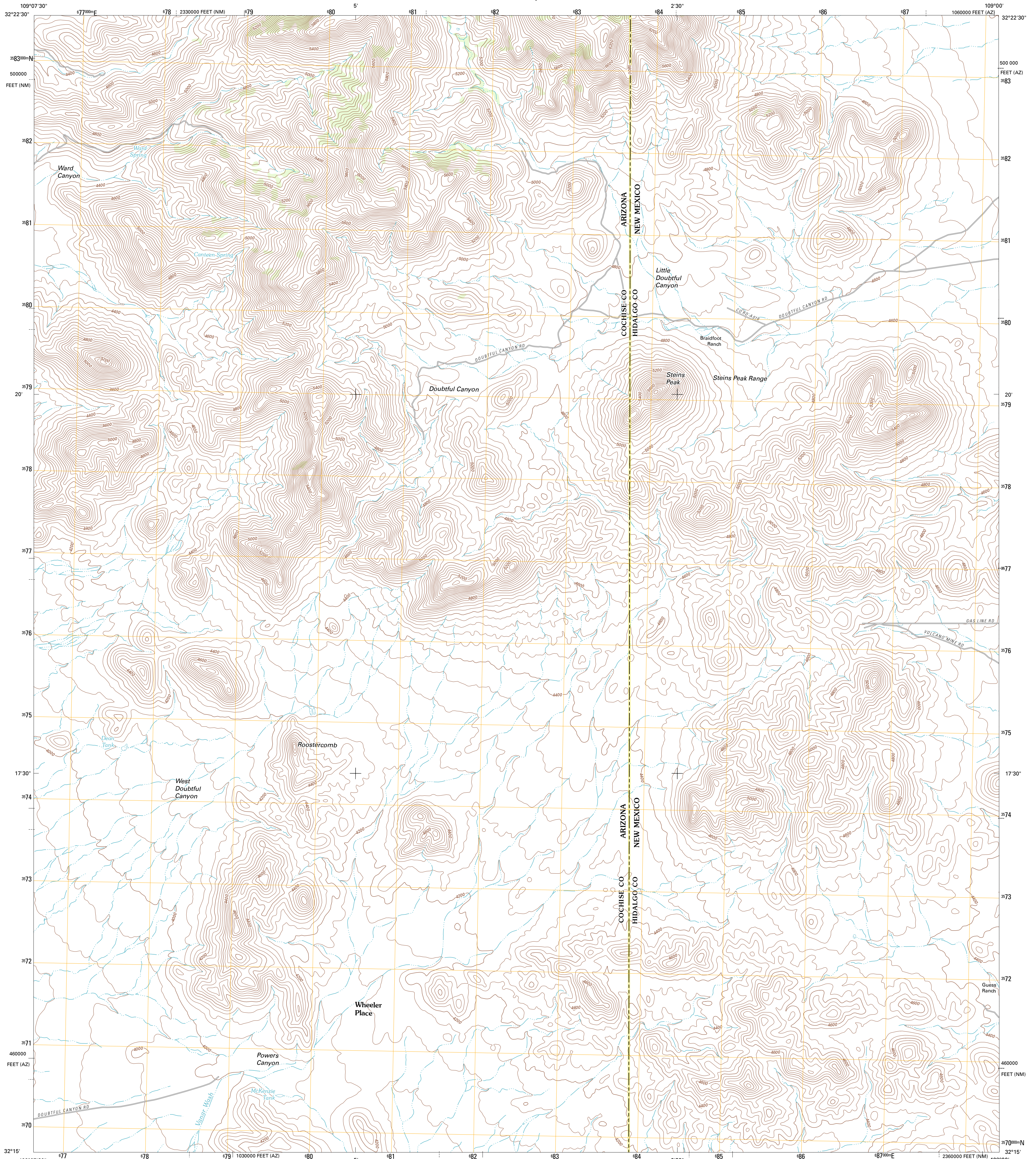

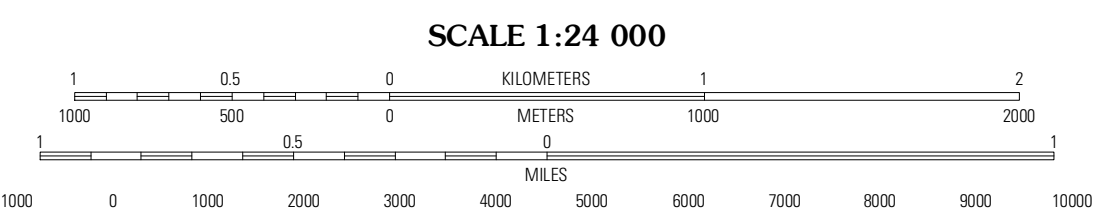
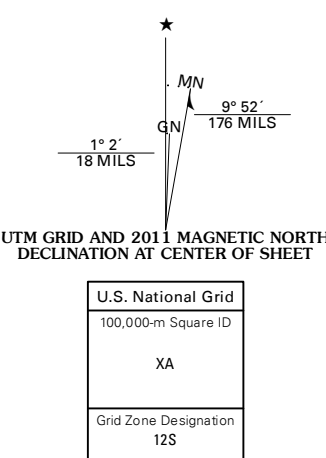


DOUBTFUL CANYON QUADRANGLE

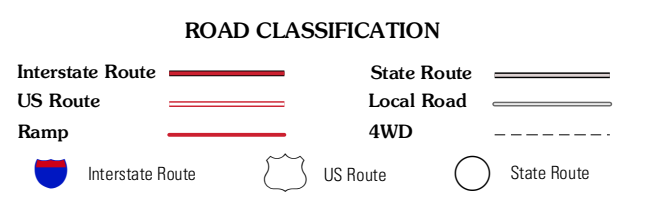
