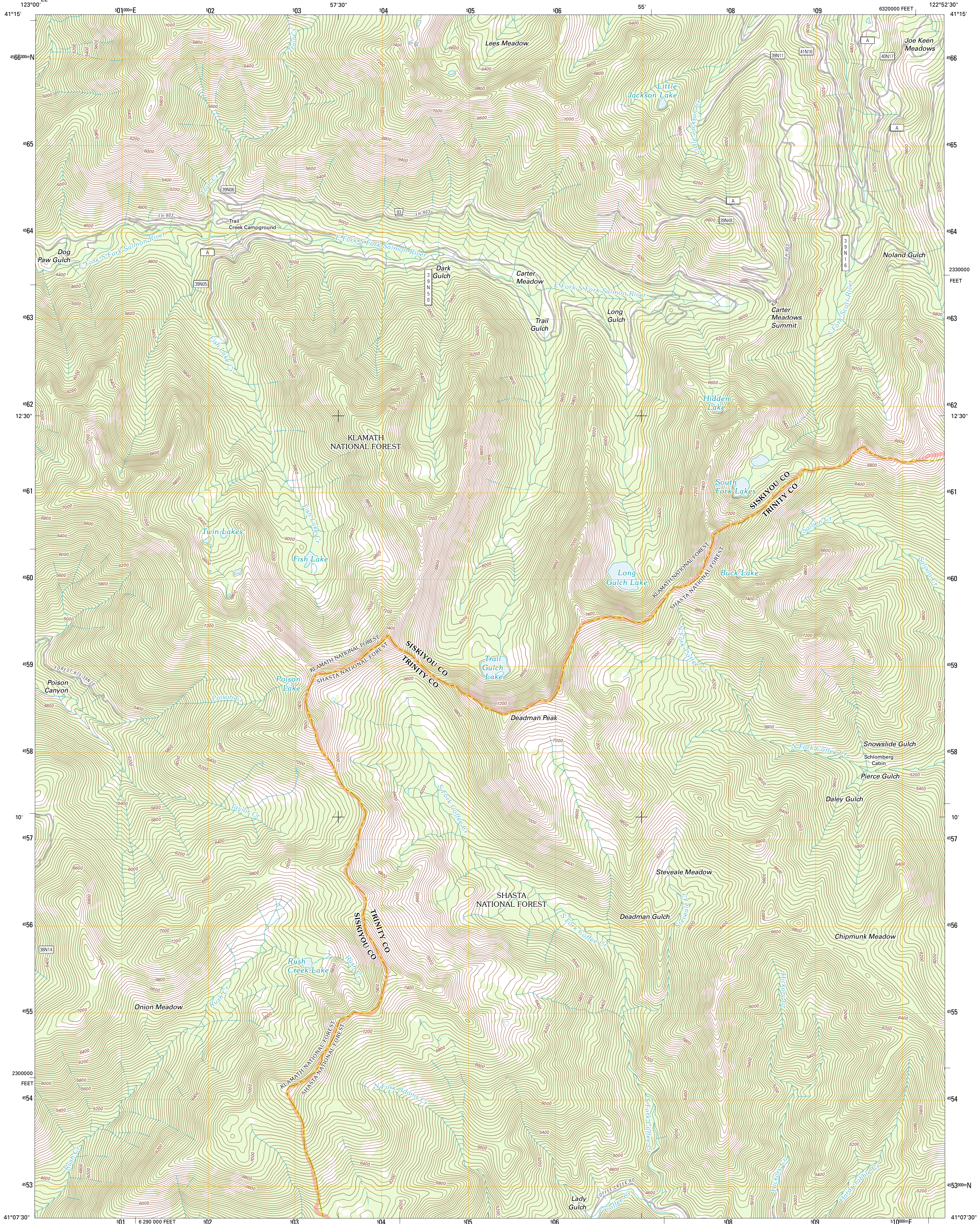

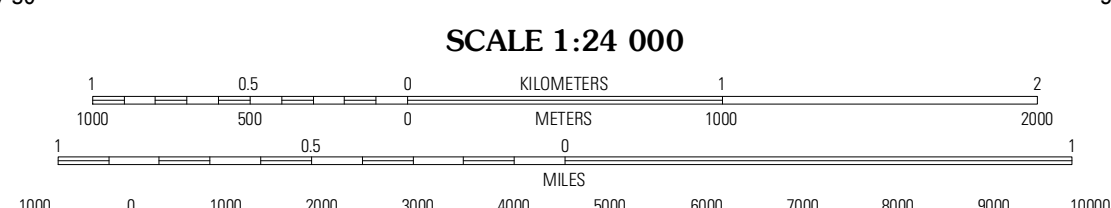
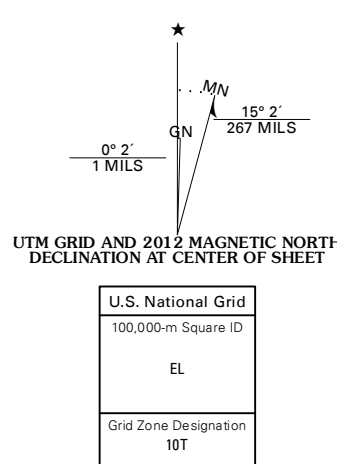


DEADMAN PEAK QUADRANGLE

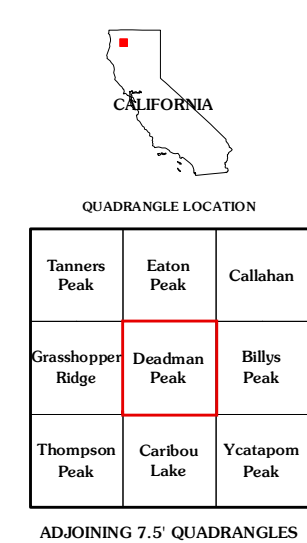
