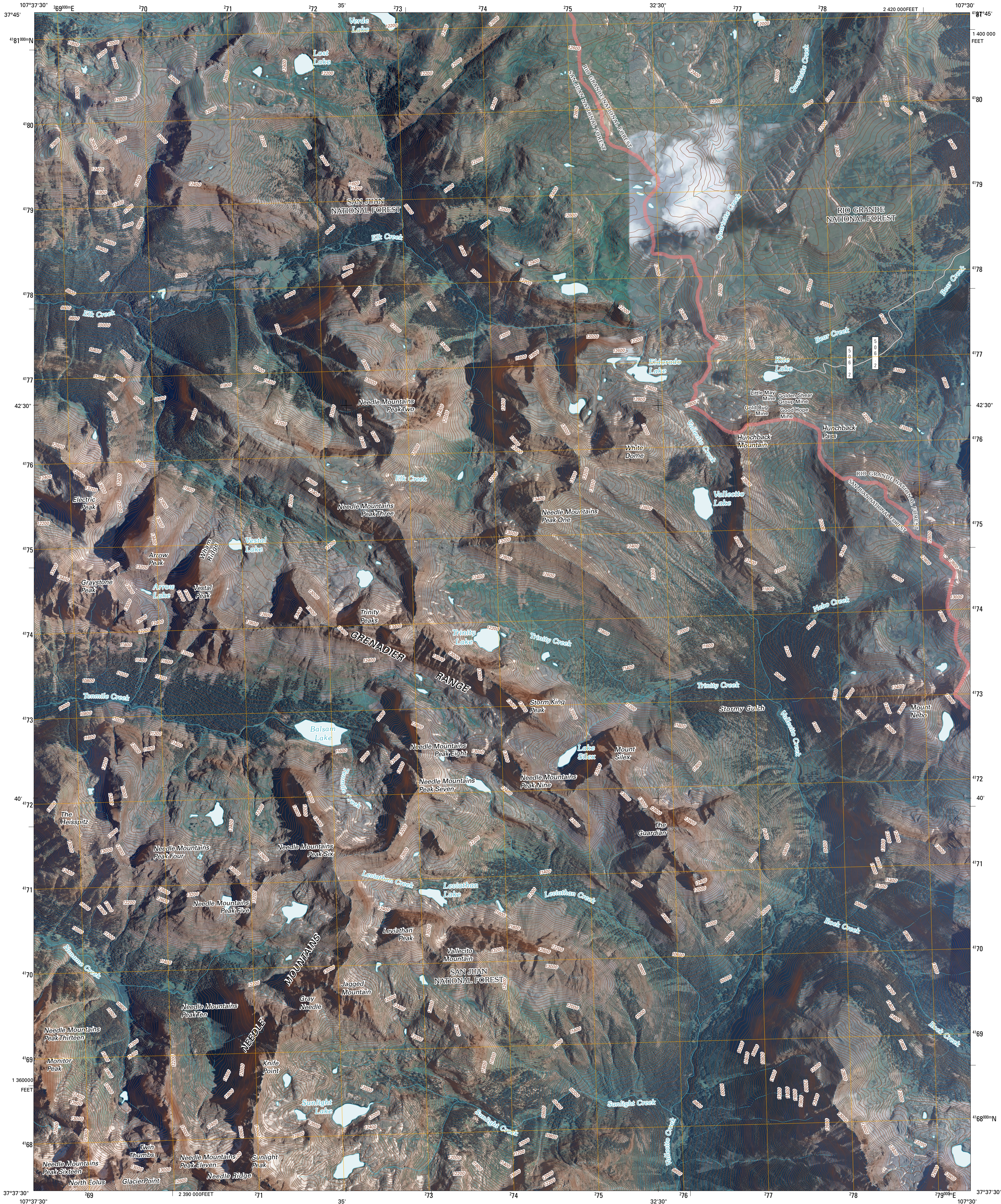

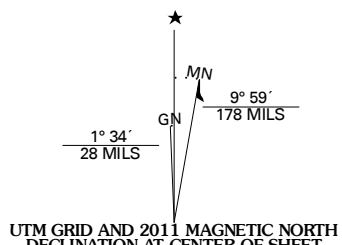


STORM KING PEAK QUADRANGLE

7.5-MINUTE SERIES

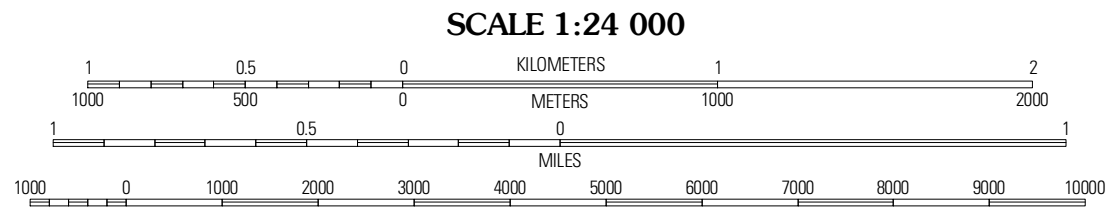

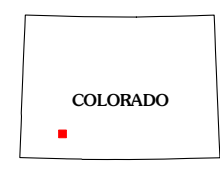

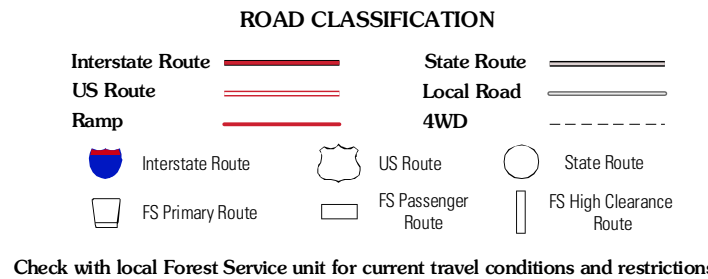
